ST. CHARLES YMCA (St. Charles YMCA and Shady Springs): Take Hwy 70. Take the Cave Springs Truman exit. Go north until you reach West Clay(outer rd.) Go left on West Clay Rd. Turn right on Shady Springs. Fields are ½ mile down on your left.

ED JONES YMCA (ISC): 270 to Page West. Take Page West Exit. At stoplight go Left on Bennington. At 2nd stoplight go left on Fee Fee. Soccer field is on your left. Inclement weather # is 314-439-9622. You can see the fields from Page/Bennington overpass.

EMERSON YMCA (St. Louis Christian College): Highway 270 North. Exit Washington/ Elizabeth take a left, at the light, then a right at the second light which will be Dunn Rd. Take it to St. Louis Christian College. It will be on your left.

O'FALLON YMCA / TRI-COUNTY YMCA (Westoff Park):

Take Hwy 70 toward Wentzville. Get off on K&M exit. Go North on Hwy. M about 1 mile then turn right onto St. Joseph Avenue. Go ½ mile then turn right onto St. Matthew Ave. Then go about another ½ mile then make a left on Sheppard Dr.

O'FALLON YMCA / TRI-COUNTY YMCA (Founders Park – Lake St. Louis): Take Hwy 70 West to Hwy A (exit #212). Make a Left at the Stop Sign. Go straight into Founders Park. The fields will be located on the Right.

MID-COUNTY FAMILY YMCA: (1st-2nd Grade, McGrath Elementary): 40W to Hanley and turn Left. Ride Hanley approx. 1 mile to Litzsinger and turn Right. Take Litzinger approx. 1 mile and the field is on your right 3 blocks after Brentwood.

(5th-6th Grade, McCarthy): *From Ed Jones:* 270 South to Manchester and go East to N Rock Hill Rd/McKnight. Go left on N Rock Hill Rd/McKnight to Litzsinger and turn left. Take Litzsinger and then turn left onto Rock Hill Rd and field is behind McCarthy building Co. Inc. *From Emerson:* Take 70W to 170S to Eager Rd. Turn Right on Eager and ride until Brentwood. Turn Left onto Brentwood and ride to Litzsinger and turn Right. Ride Litzsinger to to Rock Hill Rd and turn left. Field is behind McCarthy building Co. Inc.

SOUTH CITY YMCA (Tower Grove Park Field BB1): 40 or 44 to Kingshighway or Kingshighway/Vandeventer. Go South on Kingshighway approximately 1 mile from 44 to Tower Grove Park. You will see the park on your left once you cross over Magnolia and turn left into the park. Field BB1 is on your immediate right, please park along the parks streets (not on the grass). **Weather Line 644-3701 ext. 333**

SOUTH COUNTY YMCA (South County YMCA): Hwy 270 to Tesson Ferry Rd. (Hwy 21). Go South to 3rd stoplight make right onto Schuessler. Make left on Southfork Rd. YMCA is at end of road. Inclement weather number is 314-849-4668 ext 300.

TRI-COUNTY YMCA (Founders Park and Westoff Park): Hwy 70W to Hwy Z/Church St. Exit. Go left on Hwy Z. Travel approximately 1-2 miles on Hwy Z. Take a left on Hwy N. Travel on Hwy N for approximately ¼ mile. School will be on the left.

Turn Left at Chesterfield Parkway W. Turn right at Chesterfield Airport Rd. Merge onto US-40 e via the ramp on the left to St.Louis. Take the exit toward Mason Rd. Merge onto S Outer Forty Dr. Turn left at S Mason Rd. Turn right at N Forty dr. Turn left at College Park dr. Follow College Park dr to softball field.

WILDWOOD YMCA: (LaSalle Institute):

From Highway 44: Take 44 West to Highway 109 North. Continue on 109 for approx. 2 miles. Turn right on to Rue de LaSalle, the first street after Old State Rd. If you pass LaSalle Springs Middle School, you've gone to far.

From Manchester: Take the Highway 109 exit to Eatherton Rd. and turn Left. Take 109 for approx. 3 miles, pass the YMCA. Turn Left on Rue de LaSalle. This is the last street before Old State Rd.
